





#### The Role of the Indonesian National Armed Forces in World Peace


Indonesia was one of the first countries in the world to send Peacekeeping Forces in 1957 during the crisis in the Middle East.

#### Handling Internal Conflicts within Indonesian Territory




#### **Training Mechanisms**

- Periodically, RIDU organizes the conduct of the Warfare and Strategy Course.








#### **Capacity Building in Education**






Socialization of Peace Education Standards in the Discipline of Defense Studies.






#### **Establishment of Peace Education Standards.**
