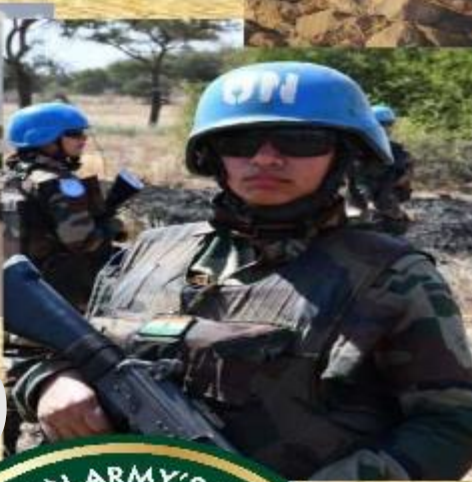

 - ✓ Military Observers and Staff Officers - Stringent selection process based on performance, operational profile and interview by a panel of senior officers at AHQ

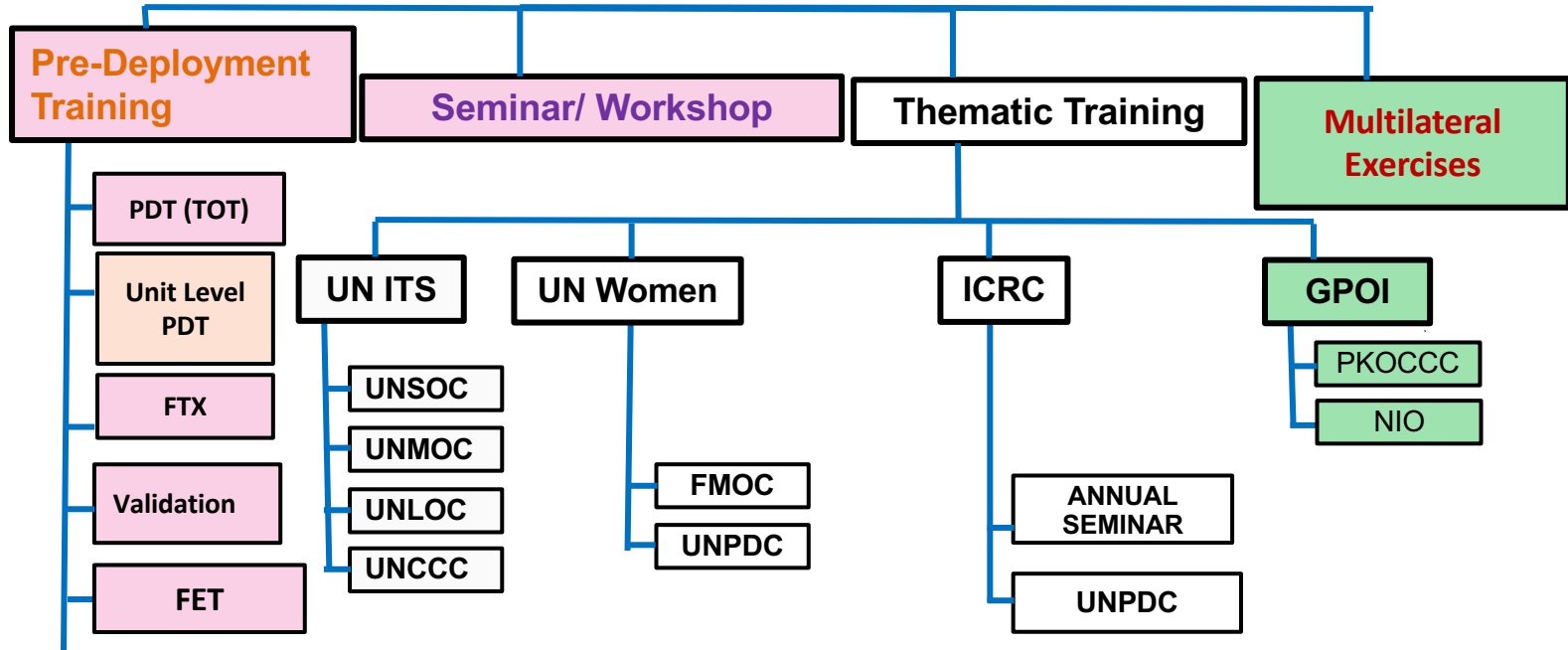


CENTRE FOR UNITED NATIONS PEACEKEEPING (CUNPK)

CENTRE FOR UNITED NATIONS PEACEKEEPING (CUNPK)

- Established in September 2000
- Nodal agency for imparting training to Indian military peacekeepers and officers from Friendly Foreign Countries prior to their deployment in mission area including validation of Contingents prior to deployment
- Promote research in all facets of UN peacekeeping operations (UNPKO) and facilitate intellectual exchange by organising international and national seminars and bilateral/multilateral interactions/ discussions
- Enhance and update the doctrinal aspects of training
- Facilitate student and instructor exchange, Mobile Training Teams, Table Top Exercises & Field Training Exercises and discussions with overseas delegations on UNPKO
- Annually renewed pool of 28 senior officers, 08 SMEs and 72 mid level officers

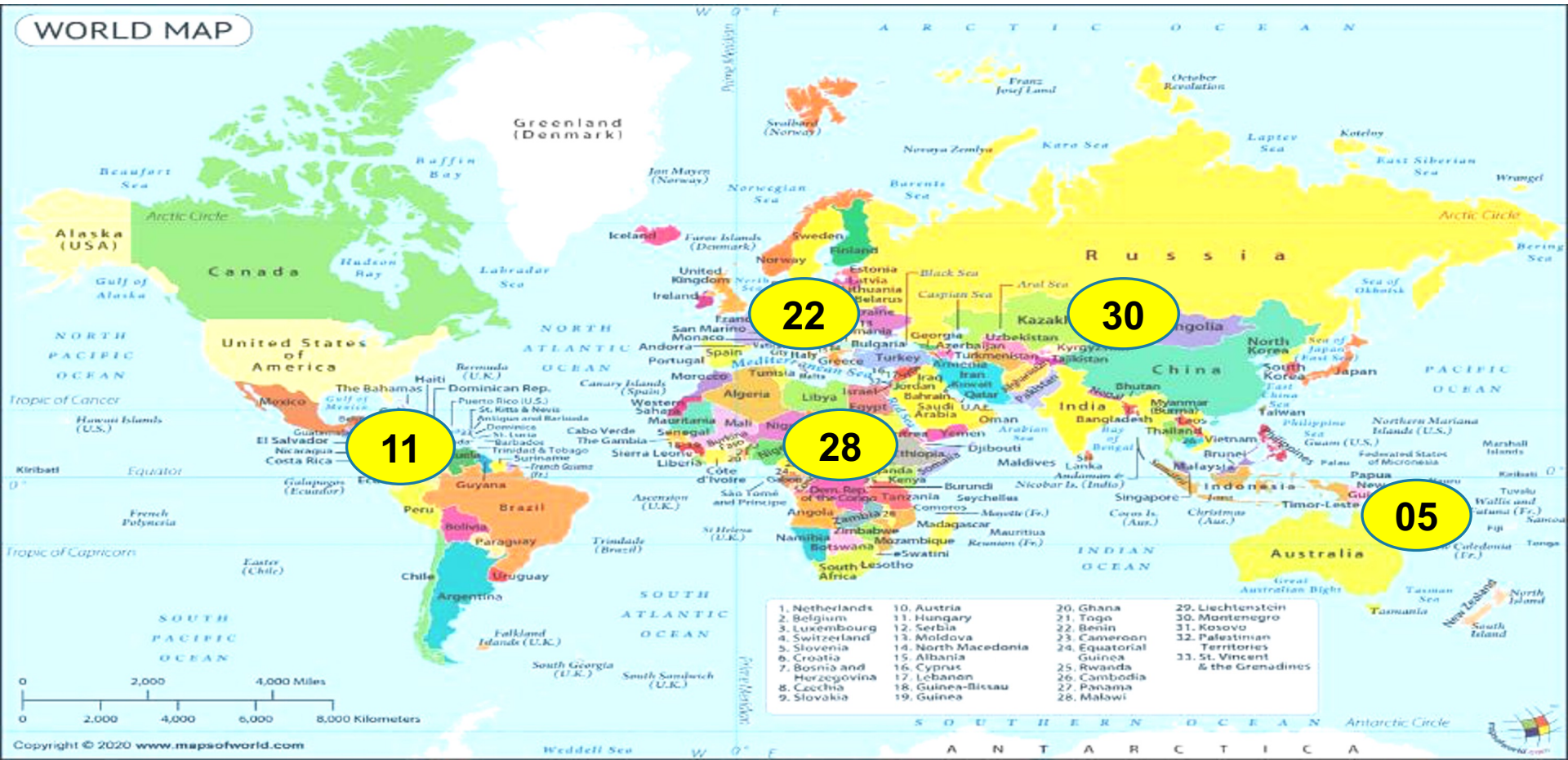

- Defence training for defence personnel from all three services nominated by the partner countries are trained in the Indian prestigious institutions like NDC, DSSC, War Colleges respective Military Academies, etc. The training field covers security and strategic studies, defence management, marine and aeronautical engineering, logistics and management, etc
