Singapore, Malaysia suspend implementation of overlapping port limits



SINGAPORE - Malaysia and Singapore mutually <u>suspended the implementation of their</u> <u>overlapping port limits</u> on Monday (April 8), going back to the port limits in place prior to Oct 25, 2018 and Dec 6, 2018 respectively.

"This was agreed upon by the Foreign Ministers of Singapore and Malaysia on March 14, to de-escalate the situation on the ground and pave the way for maritime boundary delimitation."
